

Prepositions of place **in, on, at, under, behind, in front of, next to**

Begin this exercise by pre-teaching and modelling each of the prepositions.

1. There is a coin **in** my pocket. Where is the coin? – ***It is in your pocket.***
2. There is a pen **on** the table. Where is the pen? – ***It is on the table.***
3. There is a bag **under** the table. Where is the bag? – ***It is under the table.***
4. I am sitting **in front of** you. Where am I sitting? – ***You are sitting in front of me.***
5. The wall is **behind** you. Where is the wall? – ***The wall is behind me.***
6. I am stood **next to** you. Where am I standing? – ***You are standing next to me.***
7. We are sat **at** the table. Where are we sat? – ***I am sitting at the table.***

Now use objects in the room or realia to elicit correct prepositions from the students.
